



# Eldon Aquatic Park Summer Jobs

Summer is approaching quickly and the City of Eldon Water Park is getting underway for the season. The City of Eldon is beginning the process of hiring lifeguards for the 2010 summer season. Some of you receiving these letters have been lifeguards in the past and some of you will be new this summer. CPR certification classes will be offered for returning lifeguards and lifeguard certification will be offered for those of you that are new. Dates and times of these classes will be offered at a later date. You must be 15 years old, certified in CPR and Life Guard Training to qualify to be a lifeguard for the City of Eldon. Classes are offered through the Jefferson City YMCA. Each lifeguard is responsible for paying the fee for the training. Fees range from \$150.00 to \$160.00.

The City of Eldon Municipal Swimming Pool is a fun place to work but requires dedication. We ask that you only seek employment with the City of Eldon if you are serious about putting your best foot forward. We are looking forward to a successful summer. Applications can be picked up at City Hall at the Office of City Clerk. Please return to City Clerk office. Applications DUE by March 31, 2010.

## Pre-requisites:

- Must be 15 years of age on or before the last day of the final scheduled session of the course.
- Successfully complete swimming pre-course test (includes non-timed 500 yd continuous swim using these strokes in the following order: 200 yards using front crawl using rhythmic breathing and a stabilizing propellant kick; 100 yards of breaststroke; 200 yards of either front crawl using rhythmic breathing or breaststroke or a mixture of the two strokes AND swim 20 yards using front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive to a depth of 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10 pound object, return to surface, and swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the object, holding brick in both hands and keeping face above the water)
- Be sure you have excellent swimming skills as persons who do not pass the pre-course test will not be able to continue with the lifeguard course.
- Fees include training and books and upon successful completion of the Lifeguard Training course, lifeguard candidates will receive a one-way valve rescue mask and Red Cross first aid fanny pack. LG Training Schedule will be announced at a later date.
